Relatively long-lived, excellent foliage interest (may or may not flower), not needing frequent division, disease/pest resistant, winter-hardy, won't spread too much

| • Chasmanthium latifolium 'River Mist', northern sea oats cultivar of native grass    |                                          |
| • Eryngium yuccifolium, rattlesnake master needs good drainage; native                |                                          |
| • Eupatorium rugosum 'Chocolate'                                                      | cultivar of poisonous native             |
| • Geranium pratense 'Dark Reiter', 'Midnight Reiter'; deadhead after flowering        |                                          |
| • Helicotrichon sempervirens 'Sapphire', blue oat grass; durable smaller grass        |                                          |
| • Panicum virgatum 'Dallas Blues', 'Heavy Metal', 'Prairie Fire', switch grass native |                                          |
| • Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Hamehn', dwarf fountain grass; more compact than species  |                                          |
| • Penstemon digitalis 'Husker Red'                                                    | maroon-leaved cultivar of native species |
| • Salvia lyrata 'Purple Knockout', lyre-leaf sage; cultivar of native species         |                                          |
| • Stachys byzantina, lambs' ears                                                      | hot humid weather may cause leaf disease |
| • Veronica incana, woolly speedwell                                                   | needs good drainage                      |
| • Yucca filamentosa 'Color Guard'                                                     | variegated cultivar of native species    |

| • Arum italicum 'Pictum'                                                          | foliage dormant in summer; showy fruit |
| • Asarum canadense, native ginger                                                 | deciduous groundcover; native          |
| • Asarum europaeum, European ginger                                               | evergreen groundcover                  |
| • Carex morrowii 'Ice Dance', sedge                                               | grasslike plant spreads in shade       |
| • Geranium phaeum 'Samobor'                                                       | comes true from seed                   |
| • Hakonechloa macra 'Aureola', 'All Gold'                                         | ornamental grasses for protected sites |
| • Helleborus foetidus, bearsfoot hellebore                                        | may self-sow; green flowers            |
| • Heuchera 'Green Spice', 'Amethyst Mist'                                         | watch out for frost-heaving            |
| • Lamium 'Purple Dragon', 'Pink Pewter', deadnettle ; showy groundcovers          |                                        |
| • Ligularia dentata 'Britt-Marie Crawford'                                        | needs it moist or even wet             |
| • Pachysandra procumbens, Allegheny spurge; deciduous groundcover, native         |                                        |
| • Paxistima canbyi, cliff green                                                   | small native evergreen shrub           |
| • Polygonatum odoratum 'Variegatum', cream-edged Solomon's seal; deer problem     |                                        |
| • Syneilesis aconitifolia, shredded umbrella plant; weird foliage; forms colonies |                                        |
| • Waldsteinia fragarioides, barren strawberry                                     | native deciduous groundcover           |
